Some years after COVID-19 enforced pandemic prohibition protocols upon the populace, it is now deemed safe to gather together to ask the Lord's blessing, and have massive covered-dish meals, and suchlike social events.

In 1801, Alamance Presbyterian Church hosted a massive preaching event, part of a sweeping reform called the Second Great Awakening. This congregation has held yearly celebrations of that revival continually since then. The anniversaries are affectionately called "Big Meeting." This year will be the 223rd time we've met (including the original revival).

Big Meeting 2023 plans are well underway. An entire week of fellowship will start with a Sunday school Rally Day breakfast, on **Sunday, September 10**.

Among other delights planned for the congregation — in part or in whole — is a Big Meeting Youth Group Reunion on **Saturday, September 16**.
