Do not put the Lord your God to the test.



The Temptations of Jesus

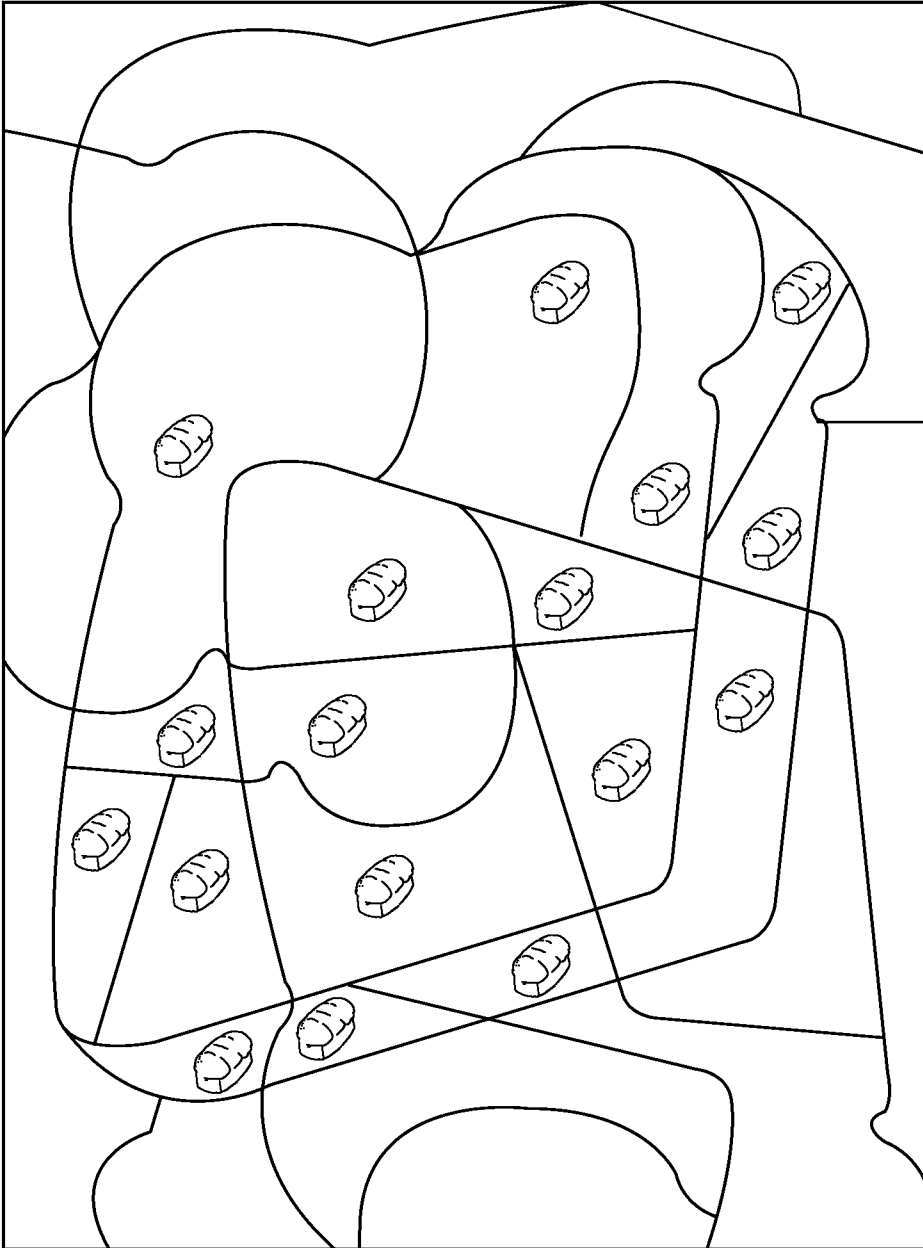
For 40 days, Jesus was in the desert. He ate nothing and was tempted.
