Behold! We are doing a new thing!

Today is Christ the King Sunday. It is also the day that the congregation stuffs itself with a shared Thanksgiving meal, in celebration of God’s many gifts to us.

After the meal in Brown Fellowship Hall, you are invited to return to the sanctuary to assist in the Hanging of the Greens, as we adorn that space for Advent.

One of the Hanging of the Greens tasks is to erect and decorate a Chrismon tree. This year (NEW! MARVELOUS!) we will place the tree at the front of the sanctuary to the right of the pulpit. The new placement of the tree is necessary, since its wonted spot of many decades is now occupied by the Grace Space. We intend to honor the worship experience of our youngest congregants by keeping the Grace Space where it belongs.

The tree will be adorned with its usual complement of white-and-gold ornaments, “chrismons.” A chrismon is a “Christian monogram,” an ornament fashioned in the shape of centuries-old Christian symbols.

The new location for the tree will enable congregants to enjoy it at close range, as they enter and leave from the breezeway door to the sanctuary.

Next Sunday, November 27, is the First Sunday in Advent. It marks the beginning of a new year in the Church calendar. We begin Year A in the Revised Common Lectionary (a three-year schedule of Bible readings for worship and study.)
