Alamance has adopted a *Child, Youth, and Vulnerable Adult Protection Policy*; a “best practice” for churches, which is required by both the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) and by our insurance carrier.

The policy requires two adults in the nursery at all times. With Sunday school *and* worship to cover, **we need four adults every Sunday.**

This has put a strain on the Christian Education Team; especially on Director of Children’s Ministries Joy Thomas. Joy frequently has to scramble to find help at the last minute, or fill in herself.

In May, **we hired our own Jane Preston.** Jane, a longtime nursery volunteer, was a beloved fixture at the Child Development Center for many years. We’re thrilled to have her.

Of course, Jane covers only two of the four required spots. **We’ll still need two volunteers each week.** Because Jane will be

there, volunteers need not hesitate to feel comfortable in the nursery **even if they have physical limitations.**

Are you willing to help? Please don’t wait. **Reach out and claim your spot in the Sunday rotation.** Let’s help Joy build a schedule, not scramble to fill it.
